Fr. Martin Smay grew up in Weirton and Wheeling. He graduated from Wheeling Central in 2007 and from WVU in 2011 with a degree in mining engineering. After working for CONSOL Energy at McElroy Mine, he studied philosophy at Mount St. Mary's Seminary, theology at the Angelicum, and canon law at the Gregorian University. He was ordained a priest on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018 after which he was assigned as associate pastor at St. Michael Parish, Wheeling where he currently serves.
